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Branching Quiz Questions

There are times when questions on a quiz or survey need to redirect the test-taker. For example, if a student answers one question a certain way by selecting answer choice 1, they are directed to a different second question than a student who answered choice 2. This is called *logic branching*. Google Forms has a branching option when the Form creator uses multiple choice questions. The Form must also have multiple pages. Once you've created a form with multiple pages, you can select "Go to page based on answer" to control the flow of your form based on the user's answers. You can use branching for quizzes for ESL students, or to differentiate instruction, as well.
