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LESSON 5.4 - Branching Quiz Questions ?

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There are a couple of requirements when creating a quiz or survey with branching questions. 1. The Form has to include *page breaks*, and 2. the question type used to start the branching (branch-beginning) must be *multiple choice*.

It's a good idea to write a diagram first of how you want your questions to branch. This will make it less confusing when you are working in the Form template.

Create the question where the branching begins, and select *multiple choice* for the question type. A check box will appear next to the question type drop-down box with the phrase, "Go to page based on answer".
