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Now, simply finish entering the rest of your questions in the form. You might choose to type each group of questions (ex. all the questions for students who picked answer A) and then dragging and dropping them under the corresponding page break header before you enter the questions for students who picked answer B, or you might choose to enter ALL of the quiz questions on the Form, and drag and drop them when you are done. It's your choice. Just don't forget to drag and drop the questions under the corresponding page break header, or your quiz will be a mess!

Here is an example of a logic branching quiz. Give it a try. Try it several times, and select a different answer to the first question each time so you can see how the branching works -

My Pets

What kind of pet do you have?

- I have a dog.
- I have a cat.
- I have both a dog and cat.
- I don't have a pet.

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
